
Assembly Instruction

1.Handlebar



Assembly Instruction

2. Front Wheel



Step 2A

1 Remove spacer

2 Remove front spacer

Remove pads and spacer
Remove the spacer between the brake pads and the spacer between the front fork

Step 2C

1 Align the wheel

2 Screw

Install front wheel
Insert the front wheel, aligning the disc between the brake pads. Add the spacer (teeth side in), washer, and end nut on each side. Hand-tighten, then fully tighten with a wrench.

Step 2B

1 Remove

Remove cap
Remove the cap on the wheel hub

 **Warning**
The end nut must be very tight be sure to retighten after you first couple of rides



3.Headlight




Step 3C

1 Screw




2 Screw




Secure the stem
Tighten the screws on the stem end and on top of the stem

Step 3A

1 Place




2 Tighten



Place and secure headlight
Place the headlight with its bracket in front of the fork. Secure the fixing nut tightly so the screw doesn't turn.

Step 3B

1 Plugin




Connect the cables
Connect the headlight cable to the battery wire. Ensure the front tire aligns with the headset.

4. Pedals




Step 4A



Identify the pedals

Identify the left and right markings on the pedals before installing.



Step 4B

Secure the pedals

Keep the pedal horizontal and hand screw to start. Tighten with a wrench. Both pedals tighten towards the front; the left pedal is reverse threaded.





Warning

Incorrect installation will cause damage.
The pedals need to be very tight so be sure to retighten them after your first couple of rides.

6. Battery




Step **6A**



Prepare the battery

Charge your battery fully in preparation for your first ride

Step **6B**



Install the battery

Push the battery pack into the down tube tightly until it click into place
